Quick and Easy Solutions

Preparing for a Wild Fire

1. Cut grass and weeds, rake leaves and remove yard debris and branches.
2. Store firewood and other burnable items at least 30 feet from the house
3. Have address and access well marked. (3 inch letters)
4. Prune trees and dead limbs 6-10 feet from the ground. The closer to the structure the higher the pruning.
5. Store all gas, oil and other chemicals away from the house.
6. Keep areas underneath decks, roof and gutters free from leaves and debris.
7. Enclose the spaces under porches, foundations, over hang and roof/attic vent openings with metal screening.
8. Have garden hoses connected on all sides of your home.
9. Use Firewise Landscaping techniques (Limit flammable vegetation and materials).
10. Check access for emergency vehicles.
